Summary of the April 12, 2012 OWASA Board Meeting

The OWASA Board of Directors:

- **Discussed feedback received from the Towns of Carrboro and Chapel Hill regarding OWASA's proposed Drought Response Operating Protocol, which includes criteria for considering when to purchase water from other utility systems.** The Board agreed to send a letter to the Town of Carrboro expressing interest in further discussions with Carrboro representatives.
- **Received petitions from residents of the Thunder Mountain/Apple Mill Road/Mount Mitchell area concerned about the proposed portion of the N.C. Mountains to the Sea Trail in the Cane Creek Reservoir watershed.** OWASA staff will provide information about the residents' concerns to the staff of Orange County and the Friends of the Mountains to the Sea Trail.
