## Summary of the March 14, 2013 OWASA Board Meeting

### **The OWASA Board:**

- **Scheduled public hearings for Thursday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> to receive comments on the proposed budget for the year that will begin in July, 2013; proposed capital program and proposed rates that would be effective in October, 2013.**
- **Awarded a contract for replacing an OWASA drinking water line in part of East Cameron Avenue and installing nearby chilled water lines for the University's cooling system for buildings and equipment.** The University will reimburse OWASA for costs of the chilled water work.

To limit effects on University facilities, drivers, etc. construction will begin after the University's graduation ceremony in May and is expected to be complete before the fall semester begins in August.

- **Received a report from Ruth Rouse, Planning and Development Manager, that the NC Environmental Management Commission approved the Board's request to change OWASA's allocation of Jordan Lake water allocation from Level 2 (future use) to Level 1 (use when/if needed).**

The Board's next business meeting is scheduled for Thursday, March 28<sup>th</sup> at 7 PM in the Chapel Hill Town Hall, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.
