Summary of the Board of Directors' meeting on July 10, 2014

David Moreau, an appointee of the Town of Chapel Hill, took the oath of office as an OWASA Board Member. Dr. Moreau has chaired the NC Environmental Management Commission, served as Director of the Department of City and Regional Planning at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and as Director of the University's Water Resources Research Institute, and chaired the OWASA Board in past terms on the Board.

The OWASA Board:

- **Awarded contracts for replacing sewer pipes that cross over Morgan and Tom's Creeks, and for renewing about 2 miles of sewers to keep stormwater and groundwater from getting into the sewers.**
- **Held a work session on priorities for action items in the Strategic Plan and some additional items.**
