The Board of Directors:

- **Received and discussed an update on the November 5-6, 2018 water main break at the Jones Ferry Road Water Treatment Plant.** One comment was received from the public regarding the communications pertaining to residents who are OWASA customers and do not live in Chapel Hill or Carrboro. The Board asked many questions of staff and recognized the importance of regaining the community's trust. Additional reports and discussions will be scheduled.
- **Approved a Resolution** Designating OWASA's Primary and Secondary Agents and authorizing them to execute and file applications for federal and/or state assistance and represent the organization in all dealings with Federal Emergency Management Agency and the North Carolina Division of Emergency Management.
