OWASA's land phone lines will be temporarily out of service on Wednesday night after 5 PM

Because of maintenance on OWASA's network equipment, OWASA's landline phones including the main number, 968-4421, will be temporarily out of service on the night of Wednesday, December 16th starting at 5 PM. OWASA expects the phone lines will be in normal operation by midnight Wednesday.

Customers with water and sewer service emergencies should call the OWASA Water Treatment Plant Operator at 919-369-1460, a cell phone. If the Water Treatment Plant Operator is not available, customers should call Orange County Emergency Management at 732-5856.

Access to OWASA's website, www.owasa.org, will not be affected. E-mails to OWASA may be temporarily delayed Wednesday night but they should be received by the time OWASA's offices reopen on December 17th.
