Summary of the OWASA Board of Directors' Meeting on April 28, 2022

The Board of Directors:

- Authorized staff to publish a draft Fiscal Year 2023 budget which includes an increase in monthly water and sewer rates of 16%. The Board is scheduled to hold a public hearing on May 12, 2022. Approval of the final budget and rate increase is scheduled for June 9, 2022.
- Received an update on the Long-Range Water Supply Plan and Western Intake Partnership and provided feedback to staff.
- Nominated candidates to serve in officer roles (Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary) for the Board for Fiscal Year 2023. Election of officers is scheduled for June 9, 2022.
