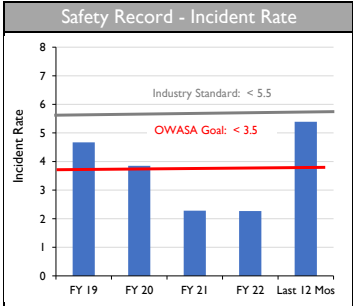
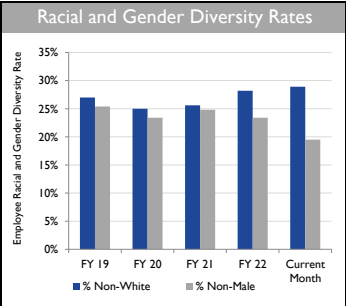
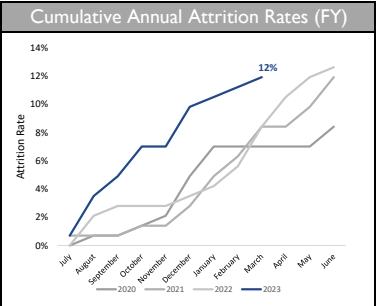
Within the last twelve months:
