# OWASA Lake Rules and Regulations

- Anyone using a kayak or canoe must wear an approved personal flotation device (PFD)
- All personal boats and equipment must be inspected prior to launch
- No alcoholic beverages allowed on property
- Stay in the boat at all times; no one is allowed on the lake shore
- No pets in the boats or within 50 feet of the water
- Pets must be cleaned up after and leashed at all times
- On return, boats must be washed and free of trash or bait
- Equipment must be returned to office after use
- Bank fishing is allowed only in the designated areas
- All boats must be back 30 minutes before closing
- All boats must remain outside the buoyed areas at all times, no exception
- No boats on trailers permitted
- No swimming or wading
- All NC Wildlife boating and fishing regulations apply

**Violation of any of these rules may result in legal action and/or suspension of lake use privileges**
